## GENERAL NEWS & NOTES

- **Last Day of School (May 21)** — Our final day of school takes place on Thursday, May 21. Parents are welcome to join us for the year's closing chapel, which will begin at 11am. Students will be dismissed at 11:35am. Families are encouraged to picnic with us in the school gym and playground immediately after chapel. Pack a lunch and a blanket for the family!
- **8th Grade Graduation (May 21)** — Join us as our 8th graders graduate from Grace! They will receive their diplomas in the 6pm church service on Thursday, May 21. 8th graders should arrive by 5:45pm and meet in the Conference Room 1.
- **2026-2027 - Doubled Classrooms** — Next year, we're excited to have three doubled classes— Kindergarten, 1st Grade, and 3rd Grade! Each classroom will be led by its own full-time teacher. We're currently finalizing staffing. More information will be shared in the summer mailing this July. Class rosters will be released in early August and are created with consideration for each student's needs and overall class room dynamics. Stay tuned for more updates!
- **Report Cards** — We will be mailing 4th quarter report cards and spring MAP test results (grades 3-8) during the week of June 1.
- **Lunch & ASC Accounts** — As we near the end of the school year, please take a look at your lunch & ASC accounts and make sure they are up-to-date. We ask all negative balances be taken care of before the end of the year. Remaining balances will carry over to next school year. Refunds will be issued in June for 8th grade students without a younger sibling still here.
- **Medications**—Parents, please pick-up all medications from the office as soon as you can. Please don't ask your child pick them up, they can only be given to an adult.
- **Bloomz Rollover** —Families who would like to save pictures or information from this school year in Bloomz should do so by June 30. In July, students will be moved into their new grade levels, and access to current classroom information and data will no longer be available.
- **Summer Mailing**—Families returning to school in the fall will receive a "summer packet" of information for the upcoming school year. Look for this mailing during the 3rd week of July.
- **Summer Blessings!** — As we close another school year, the faculty and staff of Grace would like to thank you for the joy, dedication, and partnership that have filled our classrooms and hallways. 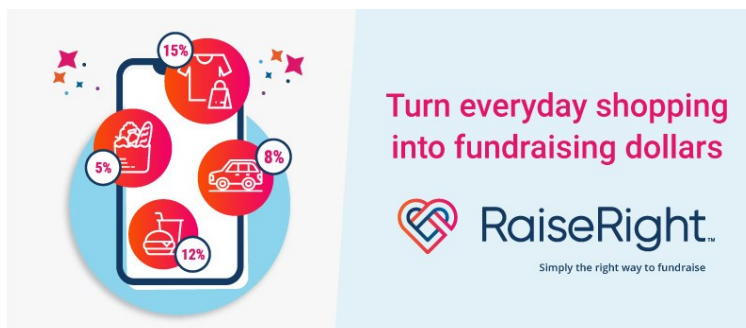

## SCRIP NEWS

- **The scrip year ends on May 31. All scrip rebates will be distributed in early June. Rebates for tuition will be reflected on the tuition statements for the upcoming school year that are mailed out in June. Rebates for lunch and ASC will be credited in FastDirect in June. Cash rebates will be mailed out by the end of June.**
- All families that purchase scrip need to have a scrip agreement form on file. This includes grandparents/friends that purchase scrip. Each household will need to have a form on file. This form is available in the office.
- There are 3 easy ways to order:

  - ◇ Call, text or e-mail Annette at 920-279-0275 or [annetteprzybyl2023@gmail.com](mailto:annetteprzybyl2023@gmail.com) (On-hand scrip purchases can be made in the office on most school days from 7:00am-3:30pm.)
- Orders for physical gift cards will be placed once a month on the last Friday of the month. Orders will be available for pick-up the following Wednesday.

- Our scrip program distributes the rebates once a year in June for all rebates collected from the previous year June 1 – current year May 31.
- Grace Lutheran PTF retains 40% of the rebates earned to run the program. Some of the ways you are able to use the remaining 60% are: for your families' tuition (will be deducted from your tuition statement for the upcoming school year), as a credit for your lunch or after school care account(s) or as a donation to Grace's Tuition Assistance.
